Impact on Students:

The project directly benefits approximately 580 students, both orphans and non-orphans. Before this upgrade, students spent considerable time and effort collecting water from distant sources. This new system has:

- Increased Learning Time: Freed up valuable time previously spent fetching water, allowing students to focus on their education.
- Improved Hygiene: Enhanced hygiene standards, leading to a healthier learning environment.
- Reduced Illness: Significantly reduced the risk of waterborne illnesses.

Impact on Staff:

All 22 staff members (14 teaching and 8 non-teaching) also benefit from the readily available clean water. This has:

- Enhanced Well-being: Improved the overall health and well-being of staff.
